¹ Students who want to register for a course, but who did not attend the preceding course at the language centre, must take a placement test. Students do not need to take a placement test if they can present a certificate that states the level of the course in relation to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or a certificate of an internationally recognized test like IELTS, DELF, DELF, etc. before course registration starts.
