Whom does this CfP address?

This CfP addresses early-career researchers who enjoy sharing their knowledge with the wider community.

What is the event's aim?

Putting your research in a nutshell in a three to five-minute presentation facilitates the public dissemination of scientific understanding and helps make a wider and more sustainable impact inside and outside of academia. For these reasons, we would like to create a platform that allows early-career researchers at Osnabrück University to present their research projects in a comprehensible, clever and compelling manner – via blog, short presentation or video, and in their preferred language. Contributions may discuss a research project, but may also address the following questions:

- What are your project's reasons and aims?
- What about research excites you, and what drives you?
- What research problems exist, and how could they be solved?
- Why is researching your particular topic significant, here and now?

Depending on your contents and target groups, it may be appropriate to present in a multilingual mode (e.g. supported by media in two or more languages).
