Enrollment	<p>27 March 2019, 12 p.m. - 02 April 2019, 12 p.m. online via Stud.IP</p> <p>Students who want to register for a course, but who did not attend the preceding course at the Language Center, must take a placement test. Exceptions see below.</p>	<p>All new students wanting to participate in a German course (except A1.1) need to take a placement test. Upon taking the placement test you are automatically registered for the German course. The class lists will be posted on the Language Center's notice board (in building 52) on Thursday, 28 March 2019, 11 p.m.</p>

Exceptions (only for foreign language courses):

Students do not need to take a placement test if they wish to participate in an A1 class (beginner level) or if they can present a certificate that states the level of a previous course in relation to the CEFR or a certificate of an internationally recognized test like IELTS, DELF, DELE, etc. **before course registration starts.**
