To prepare for your studies at Osnabrück University we offer courses in <b>German as a foreign language</b> at different proficiency levels. <b>Your course choice depends on your knowledge of German</b> .		
For students WITHOUT prior knowledge of German		
<u>Course A1</u> : Students will learn to introduce themselves, describe their daily routines and talk about their friends and families and there will be ample opportunity to practise pronunciation.		
For students WITH prior knowledge of German		
All students who have already studied German before must take an <b>online placement test</b> between <b>22</b> <sup>nd</sup> <b>and 26</b> <sup>th</sup> <b>August 2024</b> . Based on your test score, you will be placed in one of the following courses:		
<ul> <li>Course A2: A course for students who have already taken their first steps in German. In this course you will learn how to plan a trip, talk about their preferences and report on activities in the past.</li> <li>Course B1: A course for students with very good basic proficiency in German. In this course you will learn how to express your opinion, present information precisely and talk about your future.</li> <li>Course B2: This course is for students who can use German with relative ease. The course aims to train the communicative practices that are particularly relevant in a Higher Education setting.
