Travel Guide

Reaching Osnabrück from different airports

(Ranked in order of the travel time it takes to reach Osnabrück)

If you arrive via Münster/Osnabrück airport (FMO):

The X150 Express Bus travels to Osnabrück every day, from 6:45 in the morning until 12:15 at night. The journey takes approximately 40 minutes, and costs about $10,00 \in$ You will want to take the X150 Bus to the last stop, Osnabrück Hauptbahnhof ("main station"). Travel time to Osnabrück: approx. 40 minutes.

If you arrive via Hannover airport (HAJ):

Take the S5 ("S-Bahn") to Hannover Hauptbahnhof (main station). The S5 leaves at the airport every 30 minutes, and it takes a little more than 15 minutes to reach Hannover Hauptbahnhof. From Hannover Hauptbahnhof, intercity trains (IC) leave hourly for Osnabrück.

Travel time to Osnabrück: between 1 and 1.5 hours.

If you arrive via Bremen airport (BRE):

The Bremen Airport is also close to Osnabrück, but it also has no direct transatlantic flights. Many discount airlines -- such as Ryan Air -- fly to Bremen from cities around Europe. The Bremen Airport is a sixteen minute tram ride on the S-6 to the Bremen main train station (Hauptbahnhof). Regional trains (RE) as well as intercity (IC) or intercity express (ICE) trains to Osnabrück leave hourly.

Travel time to Osnabrück: between 1 and 2 hours.

If you arrive via Düsseldorf airport (DUS):

Take the sky train in the terminals to the Düsseldorf Flughafen Bahnhof (airport train station). From Düsseldorf Flughafen Bahnhof, regional trains to different German city stations leave regularly. There you can switch trains to take an intercity (IC) or intercity express (ICE) to Osnabrück.

Travel time to Osnabrück: approx. 2 hours.

If you arrive via Hamburg airport (HAM):

Take the S1 ("S-Bahn") to the Hauptbahnhof (main station). The S1 leaves the airport in frequency of 10 minutes and takes about 25 minutes to get to the main station.

From Hamburg Hauptbahnhof intercity (IC) or intercity express (ICE) trains to

Osnabrück leave hourly.

Travel time to Osnabrück: approx. 2.5 hours.

If you arrive via Cologne / Bonn airport (CGN):

Take the S13 ("S-Bahn") that is going in the direction of "Horrem Bahnhof". Take the S13 to Köln Hauptbahnhof (Cologne main station). The S13 leaves the airport

approximately every 20 min., and takes 15 minutes to reach Köln Hauptbahnhof. From Köln Hauptbahnhof, intercity trains (IC) leave hourly for Osnabrück. Travel time to Osnabrück: <u>between 2.5 and 3 hours.</u>

If you arrive via Berlin Tegel (TXL):

Take Bus "TXL" from Berlin Tegel to Berlin Hauptbahnhof (Berlin main station). Bus TXL leaves the airport every 10 minutes, and takes about 30 minutes to reach Berlin Hauptbahnhof. From Berlin Hauptbahnhof, intercity trains (IC) leave hourly for Osnabrück.

Travel time to Osnabrück: between 3.5 and 4 hours.

If you arrive via Amsterdam Schiphol airport (AMS):

Take an intercity train (IC) that leaves directly from Shiphol Airport. IC trains with connections to Osnabrück leave the airport hourly. Travel time to Osnabrück: between 3.5 and 4 hours.

If you arrive via Frankfurt airport (FRA):

Take an intercity express train (ICE) that leaves directly from Frankfurt Airport train station ("Fernbahnhof"). ICE trains with connections to Osnabrück leave the airport every 30 minutes. A direct connection to Osnabrück leaves every other hour. Travel time to Osnabrück: <u>between 3 and 4.5 hours.</u>

If you arrive via Munich airport (MUC):

Take the S1 or S8 local commuter train ("S-Bahn") to München Hauptbahnhof (Munich main station). Both the S1 and S8 go to Hauptbahnhof, leave the airport every 10 minutes and take about 45 minutes to get to the München Hauptbahnhof. From München Hauptbahnhof, ICE trains with connections to Osnabrück leave regularly.

Travel time to Osnabrück: between 6.5 and 8 hours.
