

How does public transport work? Which card do I need to use?

OV Chipcard: Travel pass for train & bus

- There are different types of <u>OV chip cards</u>. If you already have a personalised OV-chipcard, you can buy and upload a subscription to your card with discount. A personalised card is only possible with a Dutch bank account. Take a look at <u>NS Season Tickets</u> for all train subscriptions.
- If you buy an NS (national railway company) season subscription, you automatically get a free personal OV chip card with your name on it.
- Anonymous cards that you can top up can be purchased at the BRENG service desk at the central train station and at service counters of certain supermarkets, some bookshops and tobacco shops. Here you will also find loading docks to top up your card (with a Maestro bank card).
- Tourists' disposable chip cards are available on the bus (payment only possible by card) or at the train station.
- <u>OV pay</u> is another way to pay for your trip.
 You can check in and out with your debit card, credit card or mobile.

- At the university library and the Central Student Desk there is a loading dock for the OV chip card. You will need a Maestro debit card to be able to use it.
- There is an OV Service & Ticket Office at the central train station in Arnhem.

Student Mobility Card/OV-Chipkaart

The <u>Student Mobility card</u> is a custom made public transport card for international students. For a few euro's extra (per month) you then also receive a 15% discount if you travel by public transport in off peak hours.

Nijmegen Bus Discount Pass

Nijmegen municipality offers international students a <u>Bus Discount Pass</u>, that can be uploaded on a personal OV card. It will only cost you 15 euros a year to travel in off peak hours.

Train tickets

You can buy a ticket via the <u>NS website</u> or NS app with credit card or iDeal. You can also buy a paper ticket at the ticket machine, but you will have to pay 1 euro extra. Keep in mind that you always need to bring your ID with you when using public transportation.

It is not possible to buy a ticket on the train.

Group tickets for the train

Check out <u>Discover Holland</u> and <u>NS group tickets</u> for good deals and discounts.

Checking in and out on the train

Checking in and out at the Dutch Railroad company (NS) is mandatory. This is possible with an OV-chipkaart and with special (discount) (paper) tickets, but remember to always check in before you go on the train and out when you leave. Otherwise you will be fined.

Two main train companies

Please note that there are several train companies in the Netherlands, like NS (yellow) and Arriva (red or blue). Sometimes you need to switch trains and train companies while going from one city to another. So check carefully which train company you are travelling with and make sure you pick the right check-in post before you go on the platform and the right check-out post when you leave the train station or switch trains.

Traffic rules

Read up on <u>traffic rules</u> in the Netherlands, as well as the <u>road signs</u> that are used. Find out more on <u>how to ride a bike in the Netherlands</u>, our most common means of transportation.

Travel information

Naar de campus offers <u>digital magazines</u> with lots of basic travel information.

Bike parking

- You can only park your bike at desginated places on campus and in town.
- · Wrongly parked bikes will be removed.
- For students living in SSH& Talia, you need to park your bike underneath the building.

There are free (for one day) parking garages in town where you can park your bike under supervision, such as at Plein 1944, Bisschop Hamerstraat, and Kelfkensbos. Check their opening hours at their entrance or on the municaplity website.

Useful Apps and Websites

Public transport

NS Reisplanner

The <u>reisplanner</u> app by NS, the most important train transport company in the Netherlands, allows you to check up-to-date travel information from all public transport, such as timetables, departure times, platforms and prices. Also, it shows you if there is a delay or if engineering work is planned.

Another important public transport app is <u>9292</u>. Type in your current location and your destination, and the app will tell you exactly how to travel. It shows many means of transport, such as bus, train, tram and metro.

Maps

Google maps

Find local businesses, view maps and get driving directions on *Google Maps*.

Maps.me

With the <u>Maps.me</u> app you can download maps of cities and countries, including Nijmegen, and check it offline

Weather

Buienradar

We all know that the Dutch weather can have all four seasons in one day. Be prepared! Check the current weather and the weather forecast using the <u>Buienradar</u> app. It shows you a map of the Netherlands that can be zoomed in on and it will tell you whether it is going to rain.

Buienalarm

Another website or app that predicts rain is <u>Buienalarm!</u> Tell the app your location and it will show you exactly whether or not is going to rain, and if so, how much it will rain.

These apps are available for free in all app stores.

In Nijmegen

Goffert Park Run

Every Saturday morning, you can join a <u>free run</u> through the Goffert Park.

Stevensloop

This is a city run, starting and finishing in the centre of Nijmegen. The <u>Stevensrun</u> has something for everyone, with distances of 5km, 10km and half a marathon.

April

Strong Viking Run - Mud edition

Besides the many unique and spectacular obstacles, you will also face lots of mud! The *Strong Viking Mud Edition* takes place at the Berendonck in Wijchen/Nijmegen and you can choose between the 4, 7, 13 or 19 kilometer trail. The Strong Viking Mud Edition was awarded 'Best Obstacle & Mud Run of the Nertherlands'!

May

Ronde van Nijmegen

The <u>Ronde van Nijmegen</u> is a beautiful cycling tour for the recreational cyclists. There are 3 different courses: 75 km, 125 km or 160 km. Each course has a mixture of climbing and flat parts.

Zevenheuvelentrail

The <u>Zevenheuvelentrail</u> is one of the most challenging trails of the Netherlands in and around Nijmegen. You can choose 7, 14, 21, 28 en 42 kilometres.

Zevenheuvelenhike

Hike across narrow forest paths and hilly terrain during the <u>Zevenheuvelenhike</u>. You can choose 7, 14, 21 or 28 kilometres

June

Strong Viking Run - Water edition

The <u>Strong Viking Water Edition</u> was awarded 'Best European Obstacle Run'! So prepare yourself for lots of water crossing obstacles based on the Viking era. The Water Edition takes place at the Berendonck in Wijchen/Nijmegen. This obstacle run contains five different distances: 4, 7, 13, 19 and 42 kilometers.

July

Four Days Marches

The *Four Days Marches* is a walking event for four consecutive days, in which annually 42.000 walkers are participating. People from all over the world come to Nijmegen to walk in and around the city and its beautiful surroundings. Thousands of spectators are cheering on the walkers along the route every day. After four days of walking, a glorious entry along the 'Via Gladiola' awaits followed by receiving a well-deserved medal.

November

Zevenheuvelennacht

On the Saturday evening before the Zevenheuvelenloop you can run a distance of 7 km in the dark during the *Zevenheuvelennacht*.

Zevenheuvelenloop

De <u>Zevenheuvelenloop</u> is a 15 km run, starting in Nijmegen, passing Groesbeek and Berg en Dal and finishing in Nijmegen again. It is known for its hilly but beautiful course. If you would like to participate, make sure you sign up in time!

Running courses

If you would like to go for a run in Nijmegen by yourself there are a few courses/spots that we recommend:

- The river Waal: You can go for a run next to the river Waal and cross the Waal by passing bridge 'De Oversteek', and/or bridge 'De Waalbrug'.
- Goffertpark: Goffertpark is Nijmegen's biggest park; perfect if you would like to go for a run while escaping the traffic.
- **Ooijpolder:** Ooijpolder is a beautiful nature area with tracks varying from 5-12 km.
- **Heumersoord:** A nice, green forest nearby the university campus.
- Park Brakkenstein: For a short run close to the campus, this is your place to be.

Cycling routes

Nijmegen is also well known for its cycling routes.

For example to the <u>Millinger Tea Gardens</u>. This is a beautiful oriental-Mediterranean garden, hidden in the Ooijpolder in Nijmegen. The garden is opened every day from 10 – 18,

In Nijmegen and surroundings

LUX Arthouse

<u>LUX</u> houses a cinema, but it also regularly organises debates, theatre shows and other cultural events. Students can get a discount on tickets for the movies

Lindenberg

<u>Lindenberg</u> offers many cultural courses: for example music, dance, pottery, theatre and cabaret. Most courses are offered to (international) students at a reduced rate.

De Vereeniging

At <u>De Vereeniging</u>, students can get a discount on most shows

Doornroosje

<u>Doornroosje</u> is an award-winning pop stage next to the central train station in Nijmegen.

Merleyn

<u>Merleyn</u> is a smaller pop stage in the city centre. The place to discover your new favourite upcoming artists!

Waalhalla

<u>Waalhalla</u> is an indoor skate park where concerts and workshops are organised.

NYMA

At this former factory site, many cultural hot spots are located. Come to <u>Nyma</u> for your daily dose of food, drinks, culture and the occasional vinyl market, vintage clothing festival, party and much more. Make sure to check out the following venues at NYMA: <u>De Vasim</u>, <u>Brebl</u>, <u>De Achtertuin</u>.

VUE Cinema

<u>VUE Cinema</u> in the city centre shows you all new films. You can get a discount with your student card.

Pathé Cinema

Located next to a city beach outside of Nijmegen, you can watch all kinds of films at <u>Pathé Cinema</u>. You can get a student discount on Mondays.

Other events

There are also loads of other events organized by for example Meneer Otis and the Paraplufabriek. Or check out the concerts at the Goffert park. Nijmegen has lots to offer!

Events per month

February / March

Carnaval

During carnival Nijmegen turns into 'Knotsenburg' and for 3 days the city is filled with dressed up people. It starts with a parade on Sunday, followed by several carnival parties. Den Bosch and Maastricht are especially well known for its Carnaval.

Go Short

<u>Go Short</u> is the festival for short film in the Netherlands. The best short films are played here, and you can join many workshops, parties and educational activities.

April

Easter Jazz

Listen to live jazz music the entire afternoon and evening in several cozy bars in the district called Nijmegen-Oost during *Easter Jazz*.

Billy in Bottendaal

Greased quiffs, petticoats and a lot of rockabilly bands during *Billy in Bottendaal!*

King's Day

King's Day is the biggest national event in the Netherlands. Everything and everyone turns orange and celebrates the King's birthday. Concerts, fairs, flea markets and parties are organised throughout the country. In Nijmegen there are many activities, such as *Code Oranje* Every major city also organises its own festival.

May

Remembrance Day and Liberation Day

On 4 May we celebrate "Dodenherdenking", Remembrance of the Dead for the people who fought and died during World War II and in wars in general. At 20:00 there is two minutes of silence. On 5 May the liberation is celebrated and festivals are held in most towns in the Netherlands and 14 musical festivals through the whole country. Nijmegen also has its own festival called 'Bevrijdingspop'. In Wageningen, Germany surrendered in 1945, so there is also a big festival there.

Dag van het Levenslied

Typical Dutch sing-along songs, beer and great ambiance. If you would like to go for a real Dutch experience, you should go to the <u>Dag van</u> het Levenslied!

Music Meeting Festival

Discover music from all over the world in three days at Park Brakkenstein during <u>Music Meeting</u> <u>Festival</u>. Besides music, there are several workshops, films, and lots of international food and drinks.

June

Kids 'n Billies

Two outdoor stages with a line-up of surf, rockabilly, blues, country, one-man-bands, rootspunk and more during *Kids 'n Billies*.

Drift

<u>Drift</u> is one of the most popular electronic music festivals with electronical, house and disco

Pinkpop

<u>Pinkpop</u> is the oldest and longest running annual dedicated pop and rock music festival in the world.



Down the Rabbit Hole

<u>Down the Rabbit Hole</u> is a three-day music festival nearby Nijmegen with both upcoming and well-known artists.

De Kaaij festival

Cultural activities near the Waal beaches under the bridge in July and August can be found at <u>De</u> <u>Kaaij</u>. Perfect to chill and relax in the afternoon or evening.

Four Days Marches Festival

The Four Days Marches are also known as the Walk of the World. For four days, thousands of participants walk 30, 40 or 50 kilometers each

day. For those who are not interested in walking, Nijmegen turns into one big party lasting all week '<u>Vierdaagsefeesten</u>' (Four Days Festival) with lots of live music, food trucks and more!

September

Samba Festival

Samba and Salsa take over the city centre of Nijmegen during the <u>Samba Festival</u>. Dozens of samba, dance and capoeira groups are performing and several workshops are organised.

Het Nest

<u>Het Nest</u> is a popular festival in the green Goffertpark where you can dance to electronical music.

October

Schemerlicht festival

Visit the audiovisual art festival of Nijmegen during dusk. <u>Schemerlicht festival</u> is hosted in Goffertpark.

November

Troost van Oost

Listen to typical Dutch songs in different bars throughout the night during <u>Troost van Oost</u>. If you would like to have a real Dutch experience, you should go!

Museum Het Valkhof

Museum <u>Het Valkhof</u> houses a major collection of Roman antiquities, old masters, and modern art. Radboud students have free access.

St. Stevenskerk St. Stephen's Church

The construction of the *St. Stevenskerk* started in 1254. It has been rebuilt and enlarged over the centuries, resulting in the current gothic building. The St. Stevenskerk is a beautiful church and one of the biggest monuments in Nijmegen. It is mainly used for weekly ecumenical church organ concerts on the famous König organ, exhibitions, cantus of the HRG Achelous and orations and on some days you can also climb up the tower.

De Bastei Centre for Nature and Natural history

<u>De Bastei</u> is an interactive museum that tells the story of the river Waal, Nijmegen's nature and landscape. Wander amongst ancient Roman walls and go see their surprising exhibition.

Info centre World War II

The *info centre World War II* in Nijmegen gives a great introduction to the history of how Nijmegen was affected by World War II. Inside you will find an interactive map that tells you everything about historic events, and a short movie that give you an impression of the

aftermath of the war. Also, the skilled employees will be happy to share their knowledge with you. Access is for free.

National Bicycle Museum Velorama

Nowhere in western Europe you will find such an extensive collection of bicycles and bike-accessories as in the historic *Velorama museum* on the Waalkade. You will get a complete picture of the evolution of the bike – the most important means of transportation in the Netherlands.

MuZIEum

<u>MuZIEum</u> is a hands-on museum about being able to see – or not. Feel, taste, smell and listen to the daily life, but through the eyes of a blind person. A unique experience that will open your eyes!

Museumpark Orientalis

<u>Orientalis</u> is an open-air museum where you can experience different cultures and religions in an educative and playful way.

Brewery De Hemel

<u>De Hemel</u> is a lively museum and brewery located on the ground floor and the cellar of the Commanderie van Sint Jan. Here traditionally made beer is brewed and served with pleasure and is also processed into vinegar, mustard, whiskey, liquor and genever.

Discount Cards

Museum Pass

The <u>Museumkaart</u> (Museum Pass) is an annual membership card which gives unlimited free entry to almost 400 museums in the Netherlands, including 35 museums in Amsterdam and 8 museums within 25 km of Nijmegen. It costs approximately €75.- per year, but will literally pay for itself after only a few visits, particularly when used at major museums such as Rijksmuseum, Van Gogh and Maritime - so it's well worth the investment.

ISIC / Student Mobility card

The <u>ISIC card</u> is the only worldwide accepted student card. If you buy a Student Mobility card, the ISIC card is included.


Knaek discount card

Buy a <u>Knaek discount card</u> for a few euros and get discounts in shops and restaurants.

ESN Nijmegen Card

The <u>ESN card</u> is the membership card of the Erasmus Student Network, but all international students are welcome to become a member. It is also used as a discount card in many cities and countries around Europe.

No free plastic bags

You will always have to pay a small amount for a plastic bag at supermarkets or other stores. Some stores have paper bags that are for free. Of course you can also bring your own bag.

Does Nijmegen have separated waste disposal?

Nijmegen has a slightly different waste system than the rest of the Netherlands, with a higher emphasis on recycling waste.

- Plastic, and glass can be deposited in special containers, located throughout the city. In your supermarket you have to buy special 'plastic+' bags to collect plastic waste.
- On most plastic, glass bottles (even 500 ml ones) and cans you have to pay a deposit, which you can get back when you hand them in at supermarkets.
- Paper is deposited in a black and blue container. This is collected once a month.
- Foods and garden waste are collected in green containers, and is collected every other week.
- For your general waste you need to buy special (green) garbage bags, which are available in every supermarket. These bags cost about 10 euros per 10 bags.
- On <u>Dar Afvalwijzers</u> you can find the garbage collection schedule. Just type in your postal code and it will pop up.
- You can find information about how it works on an SSH& complex on Simon SSH&.
